First developed by The University of Queensland, the Three Minute Thesis competition (3MT®) challenges research students to communicate the significance of their projects to a non-specialist audience in just three minutes.

All graduate students* (professional and PhD) at <u>McDonnell Academy partner universities</u> are invited to compete in the online 3MT video competition. Students must present 3MTs in one of the following thematic areas:

- Agriculture, Food & Water, Climate Change
- Energy & Environment
- Public Health & Aging

*3MT contestants must also be enrolled in a full-time graduate program at the time of the Symposium in October 2018.

15 finalists from all submissions will be chosen. Prizes include:

- \$2000 | Finalists receive financial support to attend the McDonnell International Scholars Academy Symposium in Beijing, China, October 11-14 (airfare and hotel only)
- \$1000 | 3 First Place Prizes awarded at the Symposium, one from each theme
- \$500 | 3 People's Choice Prizes awarded at the Symposium, one from each theme
